
Pipes Lined with Resicoat R4-FB HKC04R

1. The Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs and the National Assembly for Wales (collectively referred to as "the Authorities") have powers under Regulation 31 of the Water Supply (Water Quality) Regulations¹ to approve substances and products used in the provision of water which is to be supplied for drinking, washing, cooking or food production. The Authorities are advised on approval issues by the Committee on Products and Processes for Use in Public Water Supply (the Committee).
2. I am enclosing the Authorities' approval for **Pipes lined with Resicoat R4-FB HKC04R** (the approved product). This approval is given on the basis that the Committee is satisfied that there is no objection on health grounds to the use of the approved product in the provision of public water supplies. The Committee does not assess fitness for purpose and approval by the Authorities can not be taken as a favourable assessment of the performance or technical merits of any product.
3. Please note that this approval relates only to **Pipes lined with Resicoat R4-FB HKC04R** (as notified to the Committee in your application DWI 56.4.659). I draw your attention to conditions of approval in (A) (B) and (C) relating to Instructions for Use, the need for approval of any changes relating to the Instructions for Use or the product itself, and audit requirement. Failure to comply with these or any other condition of approval will lead to revocation of approval.

The Water Supply (Water Quality) Regulations 2001 apply to water companies whose area of supply is wholly or mainly in Wales

This approval is given by the Authorities and you must not refer to Drinking Water Inspectorate approval. You may indicate that this product is "approved for use in public water supplies"
